

THE TEENAGE PHENOMENON AT POLZEATH

As the proprietor of Valley Caravan Park for the past 40 years, I have no longer the ability or desire to look after the growing numbers of young persons who like to enjoy themselves into the early hours of the morning.

Off duty Police officers have been employed by St.Minver Parish Council to contain the youthful enthusiasm for partying and although Polzeath is probably now the safest resort for unaccompanied youths, they seldom come back to the Park quietly enough. Last year we tried asking parents to meet their children at the end of the lane and to accompany them quietly back to the site, this failed miserably, so this years requirement for parents of teenage children are as follows:

After 11.30pm no adolescent may be left without parental supervision on site, or again, return without parental supervision. These requirements are mandatory to your booking, otherwise termination of your booking is the only option that I see available.
